- WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Authority of the City of Harrisburg ("Authority") and the Harrisburg Housing Authority ("HHA") share a dedication to promoting the interests of housing, community development and neighborhood improvement in the City of Harrisburg, Pennsylvania; and
- WHEREAS, the Authority and HHA wish to acknowledging the dose cooperative relationship which exists between their respective Agencies; and
- WHEREAS, both the Authority and HHA desire to promote cooperation between their staffs in the field of housing and community development, and explore solutions to problems of mutual concern through collaborative efforts, and share and exchange information on the efficiency of services and programs; and
- WHEREAS, the Authority and HHA wish to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding to actualize the benefits of cooperation and to initiate various programs, including but not limited to the Choice Neighborhood Initiative program funded through the Department of Housing and Urban Development; and
- WHEREAS, the Authority wishes to ratify the submission of a \$300,000 Choice Neighborhood Planning grant application, jointly submitted with HHA, to the U.S. Department of Urban Development as its first activity under the aforementioned Memorandum of Understanding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Directors of the Redevelopment Authority hereby ratifies the attached Memorandum of Understanding and the submission, jointly with the Harrisburg Housing Authority, of a \$300,000 Choice Neighborhood Planning grant application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development.
